Thesis title: ***ECOLOGY OF WILDLIFE (SUS SCROFA)***

The aim of the work was to spread wildlife (*Sus scrofa*) not only in the Slovak Republic but also in Europe, to find out which subspecies of wildlife occur in these places, and in what environment they prefer. To characterize the biological factors of wild game, where I described the original area of this game, its distribution in Slovakia and abroad, its natural enemies and, of course, man as a hunter. Abiotic factors, where I have described the limiting factors of the wildlife population, such as altitude, the length of the snow cover, the height of the snow and frost, and of course the early onset of spring. Anthropogenic influences, which have played a significant role in today's large numbers of wildlife, such as persecution, expulsion from climatically suitable habitats, reduction of its natural enemies and, finally, poorly organized shooting of this attractive game. Furthermore, the food, where wild game acts as a scavenger, bite, scavenger, carrion eater, and predator, I characterized the plant component, both underground and above-ground, animal component, such as rodents and various stages of insects, as well as forest tree seeds. And, of course, the population dynamics, which are different for this game than for other rat game, because it can reproduce throughout the year.
